Her Centre is seeking applicants for two new posts.

- A full-time Complex Needs Domestic and Sexual Abuse Advocate.
- Housing IDVA maternity cover 6 months (Possible Extension).

Salary is £33,932 per year for 35 hours a week for Complex Needs IDSVA and is permanent.

The maternity cover post is for 6 months from mid-September to mid-March but may be extended. The salary for 6 months is £16,966.

**We also offer a 5% contribution pension, weekly wellbeing hour and season ticket loans.**
